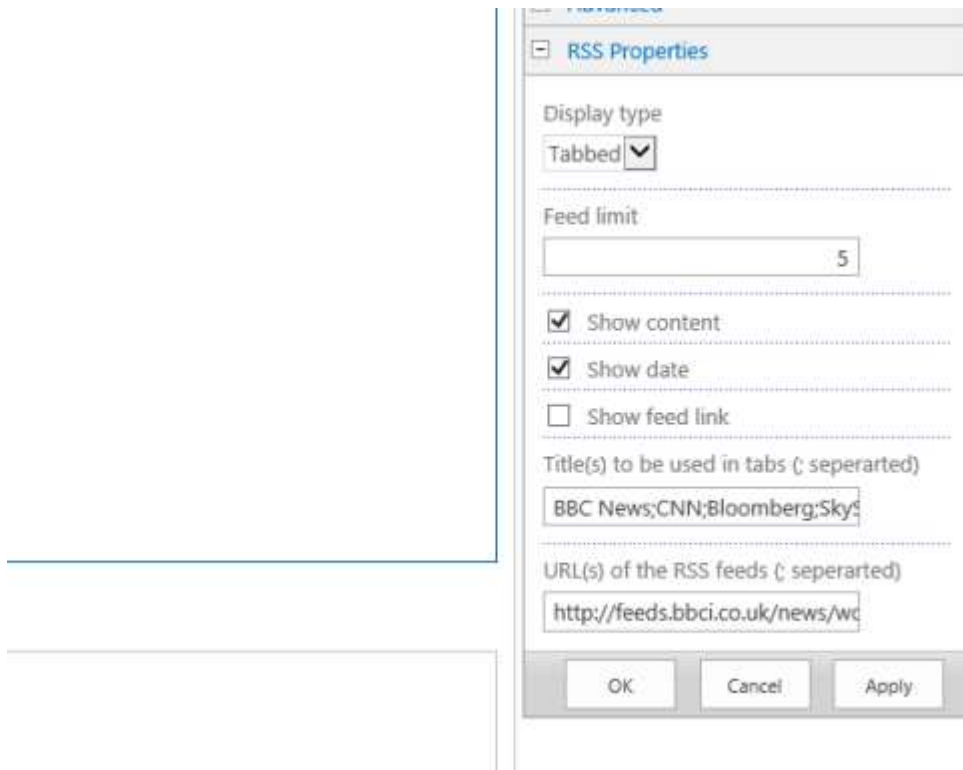

# RSS Viewer Admin Guide

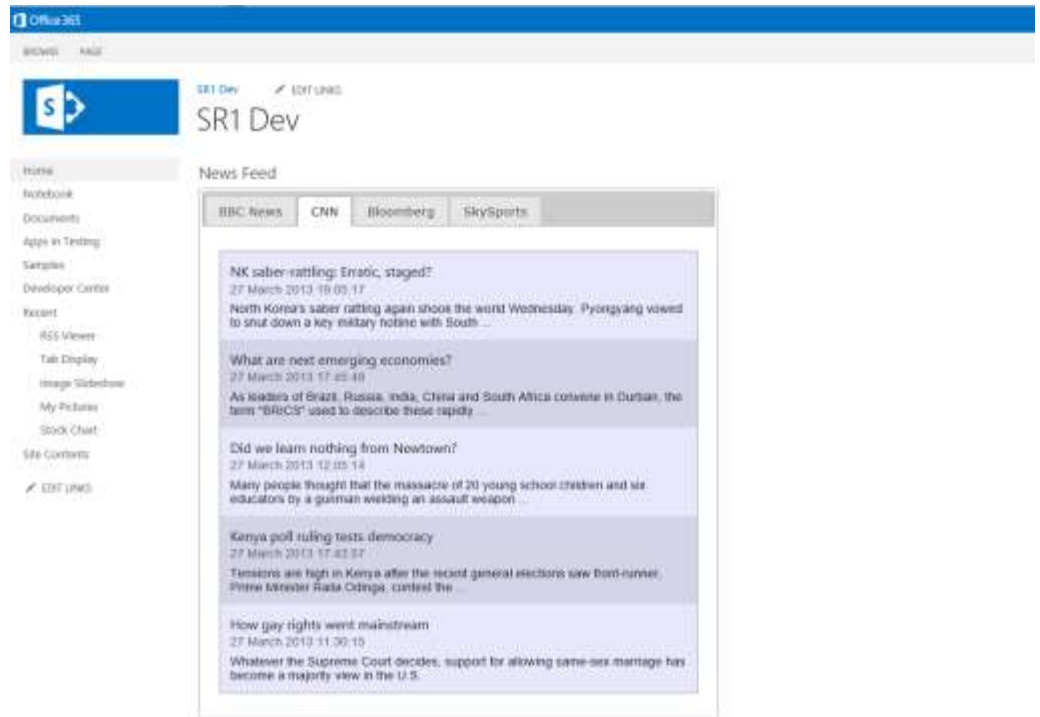
# App Part

- 1) Navigate to the SharePoint site where you want to display the feed(s).
- 2) Click Page – Edit – Insert – App Part. Select RSS Viewer App Part and select Add
- 3) Edit the App Part Properties and navigate down to RSS Properties.
- 4) Select Display Type (Simple or Tabbed).
- 5) Check Show Content to show article details.
- 6) Check Show Date to show article date.
- 7) Check Show Feed Link to show a link to the feed.
- 8) Enter feed titles (to be used by tabs). Semicolon separated.
- 9) Enter feed URL(s). Semicolon separated.




10) Click OK.

11) Save page.
